Full exploitation provides for a concise, accurate review of security issues and remediation requirements. A vulnerability or application scan does not validate if a vulnerability is exploitable. A scan provides a non-conclusive result / potential for numerous false positives. Please let me know how this affects our questions previously asked.

Response: *The City requires a Full Pen Test/Full Exploitation.*
