***Florida Fire Prevention Code, NFPA 1, Chapter 65, 65.3.1. The use of pyrotechnic special effects in the performing arts in conjunction with theatrical, musical, or any similar productions before a proximate audience, performers, or support personnel shall comply with NFPA 1126, *Standard for the Use of Pyrotechnics before a Proximate Audience*. 65.2.2: All storage of display fireworks shall comply with NFPA 1124, *Code for the Manufacture, Transportation, Storage, and Retail Sales of Fireworks and Pyrotechnic Articles*.**

Please attach a plan with the following documentation when submitting the permit application, Per NFPA 1126: 6.3.2, which shall be submitted a minimum of three (3) weeks prior to the event Date / Time. ***“These documents will become part of the application”.***

- 1) Name of the person, group, or organization sponsoring the production
 - 2) Date and time of day of the production
 - 3) Exact location of the production
 - 4) Name of the person actually in charge of firing the pyrotechnics (i.e. the pyrotechnic operator)
 - 5) Number, names, and ages of all assistants who are to be present
 - 6) Qualifications of the pyrotechnic operator
 - 7) Pyrotechnic experience of the operator
 - 8) Confirmation of any applicable state and federal license held by the operator or assistant(s)
 - 9) Evidence of the permittee’s insurance carrier or financial responsibility
 - 10) Number and types of pyrotechnic devices and material to be used, the operator’s experience with those devices and effects, and a definition of the general responsibilities of assistants
 - 11) Diagram of the grounds or facilities where the production is to be held that shows the point at which the pyrotechnic devices are to be fired, the fallout radius for each pyrotechnic device used in the performance, and the lines behind which the audience is to be restrained
 - 12) Point of on-site assembly pyrotechnic materials and devices
 - 13) Manner and place of storage of the pyrotechnic materials and devices
 - 14) Material safety data sheet (MSDS) for the pyrotechnic material(s) to be used
 - 15) Certification that the set, scenery, and rigging materials are inherently flame-retardant or have been treated to achieve flame-retardancy
 - 16) Certification that all materials worn by performers in the fallout area during use of pyrotechnic effects shall be inherently flame-retardant or have been treated to achieve flame-retardancy
- **PERMIT FEE, minimum \$150.00:** \$150.00 plus (if applicable three (3) hour minimum stand-by at \$40.00 per hour)
NOTE: If the Fire Inspector is required to stay longer than three (3) hours, a fee of \$40.00 per hour will be charged to the person(s) that submitted the original “Indoor Pyrotechnics Display Permit”. (Please make check payable to “City of Palm Beach Gardens”).
