This Addendum is and does become a part of the above-mentioned solicitation.

Subsequent to the Pre-Bid Conference, the following additional information and clarification are provided.

1. Attached is a copy of the Pre-Bid Conference Sign-In Sheet.
2. Attached is a revised version of Exhibit B (Revised). This Exhibit has been modified to remove certain elements that are not applicable to this project.
3. The requirement for professional liability is deleted from the insurance requirements.
4. The contractor is required to perform all needed testing.
5. Six-inch FDOT approved base rock curb pad is an acceptable substitute for the 4" asphalt curb pad.
6. No permits are required for this project as all work is within the City ROW.
7. Utility adjustments will be covered as an allowance. All bidders should add \$85,000 to the lump sum bid item. This utility adjustment will only be used if unforeseen adjustments are required to the existing street lighting, irrigation system, fiber lines, water or sewer, communications, and FPL utilities.

8. Bidders must complete and submit FDOT forms on pages 17 – 25 as part of their bid submittal/required submittals.
9. Section 2.1 is revised as follows (see strikethroughs).

2.1 PROJECT SUMMARY AND LOCATION

The City of Palm Beach Gardens is seeking offers from qualified general contractors to construct an eight (8) foot wide meandering sidewalk and a five (5) foot wide ~~paint~~ bicycle lane along the north side of Kyoto Gardens Drive from Military Trail to Alternate A1A. The project will include ~~pedestrian solar lighting, pedestrian amenities (benches with structured shade), landscaping, and~~ two (2) mid-block pedestrian crossings. All proposed pedestrian crossings must be ADA compliant.

10. The City will allow the northernmost lane on Kyoto Gardens Drive to be closed to traffic during the construction work to allow for a safe work area and help expedite construction.

All other terms, covenants and conditions of the subject solicitation and any addenda issued thereto shall apply, except to the extent herein amended.
